

The above patient first suffered an allergic reaction on the 27/02/2007 after eating a vindlaoo curry in a restaurant. Shortly after the meal she developed facial redness and generalised itching. She felt dizzy and faint, blue lips, facial swelling and vomited. She was taken to A&E and treated with anti-allergy medication. On later seeing a consultant allergy specialist, she was only found to be allergic to grass pollen and to dogs. All her blood tests to look for an underlying cause were negative. She Has also eaten peanuts and spicy foods since with on problem. As this patient was under a lot of stress at the time, and lack of sleep due to her business being stolen from her, it is thought that this may have partly been an anxiety –related attack.

On a second occasion 16/03/2009, Ms. O'leary had just returned from seeing her mother whom had been hospitalised, and had a similar attack. It was her shared birthday with her mother, and whilst eating a burrito suffered facial redness, generalised itching, and dizziness. Again on ambulance arrival at the A&E department anti-allergy medication helped.

She remains under a lot of pressure , and the recent loss of her mother has understandable caused a lot of stress and anxiety.
